
Dear Miss Anderson,

You have all my good wishes of course, knowing, as I do, how qualified you are to undertake this task.


I have known you now for several years and worked with you also, and cannot begin to tell you how happy I am that you are now working in this field for which you are so eminently qualified.



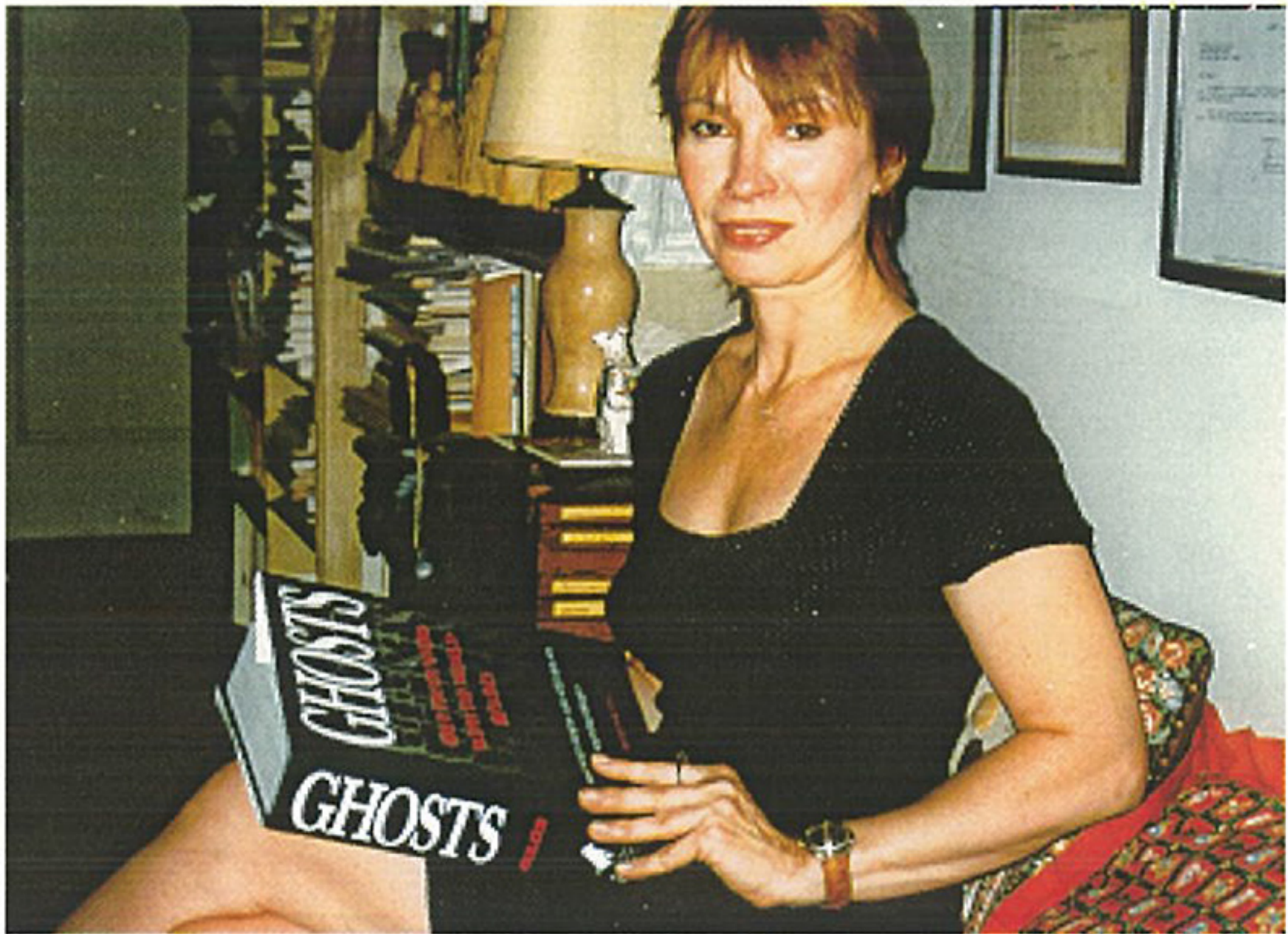
